

Subj: MEDICALLY NECESSITATED LIMITED DUTY

1. Purpose. To standardize Division procedures to ensure that temporary physically disabled Marine and Navy personnel are not assigned duties that may aggravate or otherwise interfere with their treatment regimen.
2. Cancellation. DivO 6320.2C.
3. Background. When personnel are unable to perform duty as the result of disease or injury, they will be hospitalized and/or referred to an appropriate medical board. However, under some circumstances physical impairments may be of such limited or transitory nature that hospitalization is not indicated. Restoration of the ability to engage in normal activity can be reasonably anticipated, provided the condition is not aggravated. In such cases it may be necessary to impose temporary limitations on the individual's activities.
4. Responsibility
 - a. Individual. The individual is responsible for maintaining his health. If a malady is detected it is the individual's responsibility to seek medical consultation without delay.
 - b. Commanding Officers. Commanding officers are responsible for the assignment of personnel to duties commensurate with their physical status.
 - c. Medical Officers. It is the medical officer's responsibility to advise the commander as to the physical fitness of personnel within an organization. Further, it is his responsibility to properly identify and describe functional limitations and to relate such limitations to the specific duty that can be performed.
5. Procedures
 - a. When the examining medical officer determines that it is necessary to impose limitations on the activities of an individual he will advise the member's commanding officer in writing. The written notification will be completed in duplicate. The original will be sent directly to the commanding officer, and the copy will be retained at the battalion aid station.

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b. Commanding officers will ensure that the limitations imposed by the medical officer are adhered to and that personnel are assigned duties commensurate with those limitations.


